Instrument Maintenance

Each student is expected to keep their instrument in good working order. All violin and viola students should have a **shoulder rest**, and cello and bass students should have a **rock stop**.

Strings: As stated in the handbook, students should have an extra **full set of strings** for their instrument. I have a VERY limited supply of strings available for purchase. When a student breaks a string, if they do not have a replacement string in their case, they can either purchase a replacement string from me, or from a local music store. Students who purchase a string from me can do so during class, and I will send home an invoice for the replacement cost of the string. If the student decides to purchase their string from another location, they must have the string by the start of the next class. Parents, please discuss this with your child so they know whether or not to purchase the string from me.

Repairs: Students who have rented an instrument from NNPS should bring their instrument to me if there is a problem and a repair is needed. Students who own their own instrument or rent outside of NNPS can bring me their instrument to see if I can repair it (I can make minor repairs). If I determine that I cannot make the repair, I will refer them to an outside retailer for the repair. Instruments needing repairs should be taken to the repair shop immediately and a copy of the invoice should be brought to me within three days of identifying the instrument as "needing repair." If the instrument is going to be out for a lengthy period of time, the student and parent can complete a Rental Agreement Contract and borrow an instrument from NNPS (if available) until the instrument is repaired.

Music and Arts: I have included the phone number and location for Music and Arts below. You can purchase any supplies (strings, rosin, shoulder rests, rock stops, etc...) from them.
